### Breakfast Club from September 2016

From September, parents will need to sign their children up to Breakfast Club in much the same way as other clubs/activities that the school provides. This will start at 8.25am and will be open for children in September for Years 1-6.


Payment for breakfast club will be chargeable in half termly blocks. You can book online using the same website we used for Parents' Consultations last term. Children do not need to attend everyday, for example, if you only require Monday and Tuesday, you will be able to indicate this on the online booking system. If you work irregular shifts and need to book different days weekly please book all the days you may require, then speak to the office staff.

This will give us a clear idea of numbers so that food can be planned and prepared appropriately. It will allow the kitchen to offer the same choice as now, if not better, as we will have a clear idea of numbers when we order stock etc.

These changes will also ensure that the pupil to adult ratios are sufficient each day and we have an accurate register of who is in school. We are currently planning on limiting the breakfast club to 40 children; places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Bookings will open at 6pm today and close on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July at 4pm. If you are allocated a place a confirmation letter will be sent out with an invoice before the end of term. The invoice will cover the first half-term to October and will need to be paid by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> September.

The cost of Breakfast Club will be £1 per child per session and includes the cost of breakfast. The breakfast club was originally set up to allow children to have breakfast before school although it is now, understandably, used by many parents as child care. Having spoken to other primary schools, all of them charge for Breakfast Club and some charge as much as £3.50 per day. The governors believe that £1 for 25min per day including breakfast represents excellent value for money. This cost will be reviewed in June 2017.
