

Admissions Policy 2018-19

This has been considered and adopted by The St. Nicholas' Governing Body.

This policy is available to parents via the school website.

St. Nicholas' C of E Primary School serves, in the first instance, children living within the parishes of Alcester, Arrow and Kinwarton.

The school aims to serve its community by providing a stimulating and challenging education of the highest quality within the context of Christian faith, belief and practice. The school encourages and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils and develops its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with St. Nicholas Church at Parish and Diocesan level.

The approved admissions number into Reception Year and all other year groups is 60.

OVER SUBSCRIPTION CRITERIA

In the event of over subscription, the Governing Body will give priority using the following criteria in order of precedence:

- Children for whom their Educational Health Care Plan names this school.
- 2. Children in the care of, or provided with accommodation by, a local authority and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a residence order or special guardianship order)
- 3. Children who live in the priority area who have a sibling attending the school at the time of admission.
- 4. Children who reside within the priority area.
- 5. Children who reside outside the priority area who have a sibling attending the school at the time of admission.
- 6. Other children living outside the priority area.
- NB In the event of over subscription, priority will be given to children living closest to the school within each criterion.
