Mathematics

As mathematicians we will;

- Develop mental and written strategies to work out addition, subtraction, multiplication and division calculations.
- Solve problems based on weight and capacity: Ancient Egyptian rituals of weighing the heart against the feather of truth.
- Investigate symmetry through an art-based task.
- Continue to learn and use multiplication facts.

Science and Foundation subjects

- As scientists we will be finding out about plants and animals including humans.
- In Religious Education, we will explore the role of leadership in religious communities.
- As historians, we will find out about the beliefs of the Ancient Egyptians by looking at evidence found from the pyramids, mummies and hieroglyphics.
- As geographers we will use maps and atlases to locate Egypt on a map, follow the route of the Nile and research agriculture and farming in Ancient Egypt.
- As designers, we will design, make and evaluate an Egyptian shadoof.
- In Computing we will look at programming using Scratch. We will learn how simple algorithms work. We will also design, write and debug programs.
- As artists we will practise drawing skills to draw accurate faces and then use these skills to create Ancient Egyptian death masks.
- As musicians, we will be exploring pitch, tone and rhythm
- As linguists we will learn how to talk about school life in French.
- In PE, we will be creating, performing and evaluating an Egyptian themed dance and developing our coordination and control through gymnastics.

Class Routines

PE will be on a Tuesday and Sport on Thursday afternoon. Homework will be set fortnightly and returned on the date specified in the green 'Work at Home Books'. Maths homework books will be marked on a Friday. Children are expected to read at home at least 3 times each week for a minimum of 20 minutes and get their planners signed each time. Spelling lists will be sent home weekly and will be tested on a Friday.
