Sports Day Tuesday 4th July

This year, Sports day is on **Tuesday 4th July**. All of our children will be taking part in Sports Day and they will also take part in at least two other team based sports events during that week. Sports Day has become a family day at St. Nicholas. Many of our children have had one of their parents/ grandparents watching them compete and spend lunchtime with them.

Please be aware there are some changes to previous year's arrangements.

To help those of you who will be taking time off work for Sports Day, this is the timetable for Tuesday 4th July.

9.30 – 11.45: Key Stage 2 events

11.50 – children to be signed out for lunch, but must remain on site

- Reception children must be collected from the double doors at the back of the classrooms
- Year 1 & 2 children must be collected from their classroom doors that back onto the field
- Year 3 - 3W must be collected from the door at the top of the Key Stage 1 corridor (by Mr Kolb's classroom)
3H must be collected from the door where they enter school in the morning
- Year 4 must be collected from the doors that open out from their classrooms opposite the trim trail
- Year 5 - 5D must be collected from the double doors outside Mr Harwood's classroom
5J must be collected from the door that opens from their classroom onto the field
- Year 6 will be taken out onto the field, where a member of staff will stay with them until they are signed out

1.05 – children to be signed back in for afternoon register at the same place they were collected from

1.15 – 2.30: Reception & Key Stage 1 events

2.40 – Parents Race & Relay Race

3.15 - Finish

From 3pm traditional ice creams, provided by Bernie Hughes, will be available to purchase - a percentage of the proceeds will be donated to The Friends of St Nicholas.

During the morning the Reception and Key Stage 1 class teachers will take their own classes out to watch Key Stage 2 events for a short period of time.

During the afternoon the Key Stage 2 class teachers will take their own classes out to watch Reception and Key Stage 1 events for a short period of time.

We will ensure that all children will have the opportunity to watch their siblings perform.

The Friends of St Nicholas will be holding a BBQ, on sports day, providing hot dogs and burgers, which you can purchase for £2.00. If you would prefer to bring your own picnic lunch and drink you can do this instead. If the weather is warm and dry, families can eat their picnic lunch together on the infant field or under the trees around the edges of the junior field. We ask that you do not eat or drink on the area that the children will be using in the afternoon. If the weather isn't so good, families can eat together in the classrooms. If you are unable to be with your children at lunchtime, the lunchtime staff will supervise them and make sure that any children who want food from the BBQ are able to purchase some. They will need to bring their money to spend on the BBQ with them in a named envelope please. We will only be providing packed lunches for children who currently have Free School Meals, this includes Universal Infant Free School Meals. These will have to be eaten in the hall and will not be available for parents. The packed lunch will consist of a cheese sandwich, piece of fruit, soft cheese & crackers, flapjack and a drink. Please indicate if you would like this option on the slip attached and return to school by **Monday 26th June**.

There will also be a number of stalls run by the Friends of St. Nicholas including refreshments, Tombola and Hook a Duck. These will be by the junior field.



If the weather is unsuitable for Sports Day to take place then it will be held the following Monday 10th July.

This year to save parents time signing in on our new entry system, parents will be able to use the toilet facilities in our swimming pool and this can be accessed through the door on the car park. Parents will not have to enter the school main building to use these facilities. If you need to use the disabled toilet please use the main entrance by the school office.

On Sports Day all pupils should wear trainers, shorts or tracksuit bottoms and a plain t-shirt in the colour of their house. If you are not sure which house your child is in please see their class teacher.

As it is sports week in school from 3rd – 7th July your children should wear their sports kit with either a t-shirt the colour of their house or a white t-shirt / polo shirt all week.

A reminder that: Arrow - blue, Kinwarton- yellow, Oversley – green and Ragley – red.
