Physics Phil showed us how the ear worked using amazing equipment. Using tuning forks, we explored pitch and musical instruments. The third activity had us asking questions about soundproofing and using our observational skills to decide which shape headphones should be.

**Year 6** looked at different liquids and the effect of adding food colouring and using a cotton bud to apply washing up liquid - the colour gymnastics that followed were amazing to watch!
